The history of the pecan predates the founding of our country, and pecans are embedded in American tradition, culture, and cuisine. Wild pecans were a staple in the diets of Native Americans, who originally referred to them as 'pecanes' and relied on their nourishing kernels as a major food source in the fall season.

After centuries of foraging wild pecans, Native Americans began planting pecan trees and trading their harvest to European explorers, who quickly became enamored and helped spread the lore-and-seed of this local delicacy.

Today, pecans are one of the few indigenous plants to have evolved into a highly-coveted and internationally-traded crop. U.S. growers produce nearly 60% of the world's pecan supply, with the state of Georgia accounting for one-third of the total U.S. supply.

Pecans contain heart-healthy unsaturated fats. Select pecans have been designated as heart-healthy when enjoyed as part of a healthy eating pattern by the American Heart Associations's Heart-Check Certification Program. Unroasted and unsalted pecan halves and pieces carry the Heart-Check mark to inform consumers that they meet the program's nutritional guidlines, including criteria for saturated fat and sodium.







## Georgia Pecan Size Chart

Georgia produces some of the nation's largest pecans and as of May 2020, the Georgia Department of Agriculture issued a new sizing classification for shelled pecan halves, known as the GEORGIA GRAND. See size chart below.
